Dear Families,

We have had many recent inquiries into arrival procedures concerning Preschoolers. We would like to clarify before school procedures.

Guidelines

Children in Kindergarten to Year 7 may be dropped off from 8.30am to the playground area outside the library where there is a teacher on duty. Preschoolers, however, **can not** be dropped off until 8.55am when class begins. Preschoolers fall under different staffing ratios and regulations set by the Department of Education. Teachers do not have duty of care for **Preschoolers** before 8.55am. To ensure children's safety and well being, a parent or an adult carer is required to stay with their preschooler until 8.55am when the preschooler starts class with their teacher. The school library is open from 8.30 if parents wish to wait there with their child. Families and carers are most welcome to stay after 8.55am and spend time with their child in the classroom.

Due to the different staffing ratios for Preschool and school aged children, Before School Care at Harrison is available from Kindergarten only.
