Incursion Information:

As part of our Science and Technology Integrated Inquiry, 3/4 LW, LM, TW, FE, MPO, CM, TWi, DFi and MP have the opportunity to attend a performance by Questacon's *Excited Particles* performers.

The **Spectacular Science Show** will support and extend our students as we consider the question, 'What are forces and what would happen if there were none?', and explore the underpinning concepts of systems, energy and forces and working scientifically. The fun, hands on activities will explore contact/non-contact forces, different types of forces, simple machines and practical everyday applications of a scientific understanding of forces.

Staff accompanying students for incursions will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities
