

Message for Harrison School community

Dear parents and carers,

We continue to work closely with the Directorate on the remediation plan to safely remove all the gravel fill and vegetation from garden beds at the school by a licensed asbestos removalist, in collaboration with WorkSafe ACT. This work will commence during the upcoming school holidays.

To allow this work to proceed in a safe way, the school site will be closed to all staff, hiring companies and visitors. This will include the temporary relocation of the OSHClub Vacation Care program to their Nicholls facility, in Kelleway Ave.

The aim is to have the material completely removed from the site during the upcoming holiday period, otherwise the removal process will continue after hours (evenings and weekends) until completed.

Following remediation of the site, the garden beds will be rehabilitated with input from the school community.

I will keep you up to date with any new information as it becomes available.
