Incursion Information

As part of our ongoing learning about the diversity of cultures within our preschool community we will be having a visit from the Wiradjuri Echoes. The Wiradjuri Echoes are a Canberra based Aboriginal dance and story-telling group. Their aim is to build equality and to establish reconciliation through the sharing of Aboriginal culture, stories and traditions.

During this incursion the students will have the opportunity to see an incredible performance and learn about Aboriginal culture and traditions.

Staff accompanying students for incursions will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities

I authorise the teacher in charge of this incursion to make arrangements for the welfare of my child, including medical or surgical treatment in an emergency. I also agree to meet the costs associated with any emergency arrangement.

I agree that my child will be under the authority of the school for the duration of the incursion, and that the teacher in charge is authorised to return the student home at the expense of the parent/carer if the teacher in charge considers that circumstances warrant such action.
