Wednesday 13 to Sat 17 September (week 9).

Open for all students to enter. The concept for this year's show is 'Time'. All students are encouraged to make an artwork. The concept 'Time' can be interpreted in any way you like, so be creative. There will be awards and prizes for outstanding work at each year level. There is no entry fee for submission of work.

A slide show is now available presenting many ideas for artworks inspired by inquiry in science and the humanities.

The slideshow is available to all students through class teachers. Students can also access it through a Google Classroom (a4l9oq). **This is an exciting opportunity for students to undertake a conceptual based inquiry, making and responds through the arts.**

Fill out and attach a form to the back each entry (or submit details to Google Classroom in the case of digital media).

Categories: students are encouraged to submit artwork in the categories below.

- photography and digital- submit photos, movies or animations for selection,
- paintings, drawings, collage-submit 1 or more works, with a max. combined area per individual ~ A1
- assemblage or mixed media, installation works-1 piece or a group of small pieces. Please discuss with Mr Harding if your work is large or has specific display requirements.
- special 12 x 12 category- there will be a limited number of 12' x 12' canvases along with a set of 4 tubes paint and brushes for purchase. A special section of the exhibition (and a prize) will be devoted to the display of these.

Presentation: At a minimum, pictures need to be mounted neatly on firm card or foam core. If framed, pictures need to be strung at the back, ready to hang.

Selection: The artworks that go into the exhibition will be selected by a committee that includes teachers. As many quality art works as possible will be displayed.

Entry deadline: Art works need to be received by Friday September 1. We look forward to seeing your entries. The forms below are to be completed and attached to artworks before they are submitted. If extras are required please copy them. Return of artwork: students will be advised if their artwork is in the artshow. Student artwork will be returned to classrooms after the show.
