I thought I'd take some time in this first newsletter article to revisit some of the operational aspects of the school with you.

### **Communication**

Parent information sessions are scheduled for upcoming weeks. Please check the [Harrison School calendar](#) for dates, times and venues. This year we are going to trial a different approach for our years 3-6 families. We will send out information to parents electronically during Week 2 and provide an opportunity for deeper conversations with teachers during the Get To Know You interviews that will start in Week 3. Of course, if you have any questions, please contact your child's Homeroom teacher in the first instance.

We attempt to communicate with our community members in a number of ways including this newsletter, our Community News publication, the Harrison School Daily News blog (<https://harrisonschool.wordpress.com/>), the school calendar, the Harrison School P&C Facebook page, Class Parent Facebook messages, email, SMS, telephone and face to face conversations. I encourage you to take the time to drop in and meet your child's/children's teacher(s) - the information sessions and Get To Know You interviews might be a great time to do this - or at least drop them an email to introduce yourself. ### **Assemblies**

Our whole school assemblies are in the Gym in Weeks 5 and 10 on Wednesday at 9:15. For Semester One, we will hold Preschool to Year 6 assemblies on odd weeks (starting Week 3, 19 February) and Years 7-10 assemblies will be held in weeks 2 and 8 (starting week 2, 12 February). Years 3-6 and 7-10 assemblies are in

the Gym and P-2 in the Hall. Assemblies start at 9:15am. Class teachers will contact you if your child is receiving a school certificate or participating in the assembly. School certificates are awarded for recognising excellence in achievement, citizenship or endeavour and/or for showing the school values. Parents, friends and family are always welcome at assemblies.

### **Harrison School Board**

Nominations, which opened yesterday, are sought for two parent representatives, two staff representatives and two student representatives. ### **Uniform**

## ARE YOU BACK TO SCHOOL READY?



### Routes and timetables:

Check the details of services required for your child to and from school, also making sure your child is familiar with the times and stops. If your child is new to school or changing schools, please check available [school services](#) or [regular bus timetables](#) information.

### Journey Planner:

The Transport Canberra Journey Planner includes school services, allowing you to plan out the most convenient mode of transport for your trip to school. Use Transport Canberra's [journey planner](#) to plan your travel, and use [NXTBUS](#) to track your awaited service.

### MyWay cards:

MyWay is the cheapest and easiest way to travel with Transport Canberra services. A student [MyWay card](#) can be purchased online, over the phone, or at a MyWay Recharge Agent. Adding travel credit is even easier with the options of B-Pay or Autoload direct debit, attracting an additional 5% discount on all fares. Students can also top up their MyWay card or purchase a single or daily ticket at Transport Canberra's new [ticket vending machines](#), available at selected bus stations and Light Rail stops.

When travelling on Transport Canberra services, it is important for students to carry their concession entitlement in addition to their MyWay card as Customer Service Officers regularly check concessions.

### Fares:

A single trip school student MyWay fare is now \$1.22 on school days and a single trip school student cash fare costs \$2.50. All information about MyWay and cash fares are available [online](#).

### Public Transport Safety:

If your child is new to public transport or a regular user, don't forget safety is a top priority. Make sure your child is familiar with the safety rules for inside and outside their chosen bus or light rail service. ### School Safety Tips:

A School Crossing Supervisor program has been in place since 2018. School crossing supervisors (lollipop people) assist children to cross roads safely by directing traffic with a stop sign and providing instructions. They also help to manage the flow of pedestrians and motorists at the busiest crossings. ### Active Travel:

Walking, riding or scooting to school is also a great way to reduce congestion and increase safety around schools. There are several initiatives in place to support families wishing to walk or ride in 2020, including the Ride or Walk to School, Active Streets for Schools and School Crossing Supervisor programs. Part way drop off points near a school, like a local oval or the shops, can be a great option if walking or riding the entire trip is too far.
