Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of the Outdoor Education elective program students will attend a day trip to Ulladulla, NSW to participate in a snorkelling experience. A qualified instructor will complete safety training and lead the group on a tour. Students on the excursion will be split into 2 groups with one snorkelling in the morning and the other in the afternoon. While not snorkelling, the groups will participate in indoor activities at Ulladulla Funland.

Students will need to wear their Harrison polo shirt when not snorkelling.

Attached is release risk assumption for the snorkelling provider. Please complete this and return with the permission note. On the day students will be asked the following:

"I affirm that I am not currently suffering from a cold or congestion or have an ear infection."

"I affirm that I am not currently taking medication that carries a warning about any impairment of my physical or mental abilities."
