

Year 5 and 6 Market Day **Information Note Only**

Dear Parents and Carers,

This term students in Years 5 and 6 learned about economics as part of their HaSS program. To further develop our primary students' skills and knowledge of finances, budgeting, and economics, we are providing them with an opportunity for a real-life, hands-on experience. We will be running a Year 5 and 6 Market Day, inviting students in Kindergarten – Year 4 to attend. The money raised through the different stalls will be invested into the Harrison Year 6 Graduation celebrations.

Market day will be held on **Friday 21 July** (Week 1, Term 3) throughout the day.

Once students have finalised their stalls, the school will send further communication to families advising of what resources are needed for their child's stall. **We would appreciate if families could contribute by purchasing the consumable products for your child's stall, to an amount no more than \$10.**

In lieu of donating products, your child will be given a free sausage sizzle lunch and vouchers to spend at the stalls to the value of \$10.

Our Year 5 and 6 students will plan budgets, design advertisements, and create goods and services for sale. Market stalls may include a variety of items and activities including food, raffles, origami, sports games, hair spray and face paint, which will cost between 2 to 8 *Harrison Dollars*.
