Dear Parents and Carers,

Later in the week, the school P&C ran a Halloween disco for students in Preschool to Year 6. It was great seeing so many people enjoying the evening and the range of costumes was amazing. I would like to thank the members of the P&C who worked so hard to make the evening such a fun, successful and spooky one.

This week, we will be welcoming new students to Harrison for their orientation days. The 2020 Kindergarten orientation day was Monday, while on Thursday, we have new students from year 1 to year 10 spending some time getting to know Harrison School and its surrounds.

Students from Harrison attended the annual Dream Cricket Gala Day at Radford College today. This is a wonderful initiative where students from all over Canberra get the opportunity to develop their cricket skills, build friendships and spend a great day out playing cricket in a non-competitive environment. Recent research into reading to your children has found that the frequency of reading to children at a young age has a direct causal effect on their schooling outcomes regardless of their family background and home environment.

- Reading to children at age 4-5 every day has a significant positive effect on their reading skills and cognitive skills (i.e., language and literacy, numeracy and cognition) later in life.
- Reading to children 3-5 days per week (compared to 2 or less) has the same effect on the child's reading skills at age 4-5 as being six months older.

Positive Behaviours for Learning

Many parents and carers will have heard about a program called Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) and wondered what it involves. PBL is a framework that schools use to get everyone – students, staff, families and the school community - on the same page to create a safe and supportive learning environment for all students. As part of the Program, schools create clear expectations and rules using positive language, for example "walk" instead of "don't run". This is done for all areas across the school and everyone involved in the school community. Students and families are involved in this decision-making process. Schools are supported in implementing PBL by an external PBL Coach and Senior Psychologist from the Education Directorate. Preschool – Yr. 6 students MUST be signed out from the main administration office before they are collected from class.


Years 7 – 10 students MUST be signed in and out by a parent or carer from the senior office.
