Dear Parents and Carers,

As the end of primary school is behind us, we turn our focus to the beginning of the high school years. In Term 2 Week 2 our Year 7 students will be given the opportunity to attend the Berry Camp. Berry Camp programs are planned with a view to meeting both school and curriculum outcomes and are conducted by qualified staff. Camp will focus on high school orientation, team building, building self-esteem and developing positive relationships with fellow Year 7 students and teachers.

Dates: Wednesday 3 May – Friday 5 May 2023

Departure Time: 7:00am on 3 May 2023 Harrison School Nullarbor Ave carpark (please arrive at the school no later than 6:30am. This will allow enough time to mark rolls, hand over any student medication and put luggage on the bus)

Arrive back at Harrison School: 4:00pm on 5 May 2023 – Harrison School Nullarbor Ave carpark

Accommodation details: Dorm style accommodation

Transport: Charted buses to and from Berry Camp

Cost: \$400.00 (cost includes transport, accommodation, meals, and activities). Please see attached payment page for further information.
