Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you're travelling well as we enter the last month of winter - the chilly weather seems to have 'upped the ante' recently but I'm grateful to see the hours of daylight growing. COVID Safety

While on the topic of personal well-being, it's a good time for a reminder about how we can all play our part in keeping our school and community safe in these uncertain times. Staff are practising social distancing and regular sanitising, along with helping students to practise good hygiene regularly. We shared the Chief Health Officer (CHO) Roadmap advice for schools with you recently to give insight into what events can and can't resume and procedures schools need to continue. The increased cleaning throughout the day has continued and we are grateful to you, our parent community, for your support through not entering classroom buildings, maintaining social distance when waiting for your children, keeping your children home if they are showing any cold or flu like signs or symptoms and quarantining family units if a member has undergone a COVID test. We are also grateful to those of you who continue to use the marked entry and exit gates around the school appropriately as this reduces confusion and aids in social distancing.

End of Year Events

In line with the CHO's Roadmap, we made some difficult decisions recently related to end of year events. Unfortunately, the end of year concert won't go ahead this year and while we are holding out hope, I don't think we are going to be able to hold a Year 10 Formal either. If circumstances remain as they are (or improve), we do intend to hold the Year 10 Graduation (live streamed to parents/carers rather than you being physically in attendance) and present students with ACE Awards (in classes rather than our regular

ACE Ceremony. These were disappointing decisions to make and certainly not what any of us envisaged at the start of the year.

Current Happenings

On a brighter note, congratulations are warranted for Kanchana I, one of our Learning Support Assistants, for winning a scholarship to support studies to complete a Certificate IV in Education Support. As a place of learning, we are continuing our partnership with the University of Canberra through hosting pre-service teachers (in much reduced numbers) as part of their journey to becoming qualified teachers. And in another step towards a sense of 'normality', we have students participating in the Australian Geography Competition this week.

Diversity is Our Strength

As part of an annual process of review of support for students, teachers recently completed the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data, which focuses on adjustments teachers make to support successful learning for all students. In a school our size this is a significant, but worthwhile event, as we take time to moderate and review supports and adjustments we make along with resources available to achieve these. It's also a great opportunity for teachers to reflect on and share great teaching practice as we strive to meet the needs of all learners and I thank them for their enthusiastic participation.

Rail Safety Week

Next week is Rail Safety Week and this year we are again working closely with Transport Canberra to provide important safety information for students in relation to travelling on and moving around the light rail. It's a good opportunity for us all to revisit the need to be alert and pay attention when in and around light rail vehicles and to consider the role modelling, we can do for kids.

If your child has been given a change of clothing by the school, please wash and return them to the Front Office as soon as possible, as we are running extremely low. Thank you for your cooperation.


LIBRARY NEWS

2020 REVIEW - DISABILITY STANDARDS FOR EDUCATION 2005

The [Disability Standards for Education 2005](#) (the Standards) help make sure students with disability in Australia can access and participate in education on the same basis as students without disability. The Australian Government Department of Education, Skills and Employment, on behalf of the Minister for Education, is undertaking a review of the Standards through an extensive community consultation process. The Standards are reviewed every five years to test if they are effective in achieving their objectives and whether any improvements could be made.

Current, former and prospective students with disability, their families and carers, advocates, educators and other members of the public are invited to share their experiences, views and ideas to inform the Review of the Standards. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, engagement activities will mostly be held online via a dedicated 2020 Review [Consultation Hub](#). To register to be involved or to make a submission visit the [Consultation Hub](#). The consultations are open until 11.59pm AEST on Friday, 25 September 2020.
