On Thursday 3 September, we have a special visit from Author and Illustrator Dr Cameron Stelzer.

Dr Cameron is visiting Harrison School to run workshops with our K-2 students:

- Kinder will join Cameron for an interactive Big Screen Book Reading and follow-along drawing adventure, discovering how characters, colour and sounds blend like the first notes of a storytelling symphony.
- Year 1-2 will take a backstage pass into the creation of an illustrated chapter book series, uncovering the layers of narrative, illustration, and imagination that work together like instruments in a symphony.

Students and teachers are looking forward to an inspiring celebration of writing, reading, and creativity - a true concert of ideas!

In conjunction with the Author Visit, Harrison families have a special opportunity to purchase signed and personalised copies of Cameron's books at special prices. Individual books are \$10-\$15 each and there are also exclusive book sets available.
